To teach and train others to be Jesus disciples too. All others. Everywhere! (2 Corinthians 5)

Two of the Gospels end with Jesus telling Jesus His disciples to "Go...."

Go to whom? Everyone!

Go where? Everywhere!

But it'll only work if we are yielded to, guided by, and empowered with the Holy Spirit. Are you allowing Him to carry you through life and direct your steps?
